PACKET PICK UP

IMPORTANT INFORMATION **PHOTO ID REQUIRED**

If you are picking up a packet for another person, you MUST have a picture or physical copy of their photo ID. No exceptions.

Packets will be distributed by event and the first letters of your surname. Designations are hung above the packet pickup area.

Please be sure to verify the information on your bib label is accurate. If not, please make contact with a Pink Run staff at packet pickup.

RESULTS

Want accurate event results? Wear your bib properly and do not tamper with the B-tag.

CHRONOTRACK B-TAG TIMING (BIB TAG)

Do NOT remove the B-Tag from your race number. Please leave the B-Tag on the back of your race number and pin your race number on the front of your shirt.

RACE DAY

PARKING

Adequate parking is available at Fort Charlotte (between Cricket Club, Chippingham Road and the side streets) for all participants.

Plan on arriving early as the streets will be closed from 5:00 am to accommodate the marathon.

There will be specific crossing areas from Fort Charlotte to Western Esplanade so as not to interfere with the clear running passage of the marathoners. These will be manned by the Royal Bahamas Police Force.

Late arrival may result in your having to take the back roads to the Fort, may be delayed from crossing Bay Street to the Esplanade and missing the starting gun.

RACE START 6:45 am (sharp)

RACE LOCATION

The 11th running of The Pink Run 5k will start at the Western Esplanade, Bay Street. Western Esplanade is a popular beach with the locals as well as tourists and has an incredible view of the arriving cruise ships going to Nassau harbor.

Western Esplanade is two miles southwest of Paradise Island, three miles east of Cable Beach and an easy walk from downtown.



<u>RACE COURSE</u>

The new flat course is suited for runners and walkers, is family oriented and engenders camaraderie.

The 5K starts at Western Esplanade heading east through downtown Nassau via Woodes Rodgers Wharf and existing on Parliament Street to Bay Street with a turnaround at Christie Street and continuing on Bay to the eastern entrance of Western Esplanade for a dramatic oceanfront finish.

COURSE INFORMATION

Mile markers will be placed at every mile There will be two water stops (Rawson Square) Participant verification will be at the turnaround point Strollers are allowed on the course but must be at the rear. NO EXCEPTION. Walkers are **NOT** allowed at the front of the starting line. This is for the safety of all.

THE PINK RUN 5k and **MARATHON BAHAMAS** (marathon, half marathon and relay) will be sharing the same course from Christie Street to entrance of Western Esplanade.

Heading east on Bay, you must stay to the left (north) of the cones. Returning west, you must stay to the left of the barricades. You are now allowed to cross over the barricades and go to the southern side of Bay and restrict the free movement of the marathoners. There will be course marshals along this area to enforce this rule.

Please cheer the returning marathoners – get them excited and fired up....they will still have another 20 - 22 miles to run.

MEDICAL/RECOVERY SUPPORT

If one is in need of medical assistance, please notify any volunteer and they will help you in obtaining medical assistance.

A medical tent will be at the finish line.

PORT-O-JOHNS

Portable toilets will be available at the start/finish line.

FINISH LINE

Finishers will be presented with their finisher's medal along with bottled water as they enter the chute to the left. Keep walking through the chute so as not to prevent other finishers clear passage through the area.

RUNNERS' REFRESHMENTS

Refreshments will be available at Race Village.

VENDORS

At Race Village, there will be numerous vendors displaying, selling, sampling, and distributing their services and products. Please patronize their stalls/tents.

ENTERTAINMENT

At Race Village, there will be live performances by: Novie, Nishe L.S., Donrika, and lots more.

RUNNER RESULTS

THE PINK RUN 5k will be utilizing a single-use bib tag – that records each runners official time. In order to receive accurate timing, please make sure your bib is:

- Clearly visible in front of your torso
- Unaltered and unmodified (do not fold or wrinkle)
- Pin in all four corners
- Not covered (jackets, runners belt, water bottle, etc)
- No activation of the device is necessary

Race results will be posted online at MarathonBahamas.com

Overall awards will be based on gun time and the masters and age group awards will be based on **net time**. YOUR TIME DOES NOT START UNTIL YOU CROSS THE STARTING MAT.

There will be a tent, at Race Village, and on stage with a QR code for you to obtain your results.

AWARDS

Overall male/female; master male/female; overall survivor winners will be awarded their awards

Age-group winners will be directed to a tent to receive their award

TEAMS AWARDS will be announced immediately after the overall results.

Please note: We will **not** hand out awards before the official awards ceremony.
