### **RACE LOCATION**

The 14<sup>th</sup> running of Sunshine Insurance Marathon Bahamas will start at the Western Esplanade, Bay Street. Western Esplanade is a popular beach with the locals as well as tourists and has an incredible view of the arriving cruise ships going to Nassau Harbour.

Western Esplanade is two miles southwest of Paradise Island, three miles east of Cable Beach and an easy walk from downtown.









### **PACKET PICK UP**

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

If you are picking up a packet for another person, you MUST have a picture or physical copy of their photo ID. No exceptions.

Packets will be distributed by event and the first letters of your surname. Designations are hung above the packet pickup area.

### THERE IS NO REGISTRATION OR PACKET PICKUP ON RACE MORNING

#### **PACKET INCLUSIONS:**

- Bib
- Safety pins
- Technical Race Shirt
- Drawstring bag

#### INFORMATION VERIFICATION

Please be sure to verify the information on your bib label is accurate. If not, please make contact with a Marathon Bahamas staff at packet pickup.

#### REGISTRATION

If spots are available, you can register at Packet Pick Up.

#### **RESULTS**

Want accurate event results? Wear your bib properly and do not tamper with the B-tag.

#### CHRONOTRACK B-TAG TIMING (BIB TAG)

Do NOT remove the B-Tag from your race number. Please leave the B-Tag on the back of your race number and pin your race number on the front of your shirt.

The marathon and half marathon courses are IAAF and AIMS certified courses.

Your results from this incredibly beautiful, flat marathon course can be used as a BOSTON QUALIFIER.

Marathon Bahamas is a qualifying event for the Abbott World Marathon Majors Wanda Age Group Championships.

### **RACE DAY**

#### **PARKING**

Adequate parking is available at Fort Charlotte (between Cricket Club, Chippingham Road and side streets) for all participants.

Plan on arriving early as the streets will be closed from 5:00am. Late arrival may result in your having to take the back roads to the fort and missing the starting gun.

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

4:45 am

Pick up from Atlantis Coral Towers, Grand Hyatt

9:15 am, 10:45 am, 12:00 noon

Return Transportation to Atlantis Coral Towers, Grand Hyatt

Pick up is same spot as drop off: Chippingham and Bay Streets One-way or round-trip bus tickets can be purchased at Packet Pick Up

#### **RELAY TEAMS**

#3 – Seabeach Boulevard West...13.1; #4 – Cave's Heights...30k

Depart from Chippingham and Bay Streets for relay exchange 3 and 4

8:30 am, 9:15 am, 10:15 am

Transport from entrance of Seabeach Boulevard (west entrance)
Relay exchange #3 (walk west to next corner – one block)
Relay exchange #4 (walk east to next corner – four blocks)

**RACE START** 

6:00 am

#### **GEAR CHECK/PICK UP**

5:00 am - noon

Please use the perforated label, from your bib, and attach it to your drawstring bag. The gear check area is on the north western end of beachside.

#### ABSOLUTELY NO BACKPACKS OR COOLERS WILL BE ACCEPTED

### **RACE COURSE**

The new course is flat, fast and furiously scenic making for the possibility of PRs!

The marathon starts at Western Esplanade heading east through downtown Nassau via Woodes Rodgers Wharf and existing on Parliament Street to Bay Street. Route continues east to Montagu Beach (exit) making a turnaround at Montague Beach (entrance). The course loops west returning to downtown and hugging the northern shores of Cable Beach, Delaporte and West Bay Street with the turnaround at Columbus Cove. The dramatic finish is via the eastern entrance of Western Esplanade – oceanfront!

With the exception of the Saunders Beach roundabout, all roundabouts are on the northern shoreline. There will be barricades, signage and marshals along the course for guidance.

#### CLICK HERE TO VIEW RACE COURSE

The half marathon route mirrors the marathon with the turnaround at the eastern wing of Grand Hyatt.

#### **RELAY EXCHANGES**

- #1. Marriott Courtyard (10k)

  Completion of the first leg participants will be two blocks west from the finish line.
- #2. Seabeach Boulevard (west of SunFun Resort (13.1)
- #3. Cave's Heights (30k)

#### **COURSE INFORMATION**

Splits and clocks will be along the course. Clocks will be displayed at each timing split site. Each mile will be marked along the course.

#### **HYDRATION STATIONS**

Stations will be set up at the start and finish lines and throughout the breath of the course starting at mile #2.

and payant will be at every mile. GU brand gels will be available at mile #10 for half marathon and miles #12 and #22 for the marathoners.

#### SPONGE STATIONS

Sponges will be available at 19.5 miles.

#### **PORT-O-JOHNS**

Portable toilets provided by will be available at the start/finish line, and additional locations along the course.

#### **COURSE TIME LIMIT** (6 hours)

A 13.40 minute per mile pace must be maintained for all athletes in the marathon to complete the event in the allotted six hours.

As a courtesy to runner participants, please do not walk more than two abreast so that runners can easily pass.

Strollers, bicycles, dogs and other unauthorized vehicles are **not** permitted on the course. Bicycles, etc. used to pace or support a runner will result in the runner being disqualified.

#### MEDICAL/RECOVERY SUPPORT

If one is in need of medical assistance, please notify any volunteer and they will help you in obtaining medical assistance.

There will be three medical tents along the course: mile #7.5, mile #11, mile #14 and returning at the same locations.

The main medical tent will be at the finish line and will be manned by personnel from POCTORS HOSPITAL.

#### **EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION**

Write your full name, emergency contact information, and any allergies or health conditions you have on the back of your race bib. Please be sure to print information clearly.

### **RACE VILLAGE**

#### THE PINK RUN 5k

THE PINK RUN 5k will be celebrating their accomplishment at the same time as Marathon Bahamas (park side) 6:45 – 9:00 am. Please feel free to visit Race Village 5k and enjoy the entertainment, celebration, vendors offerings and commaraderie.

#### PHYSIOTHERAPHY SERVICES

For those requiring physiotherapy services, Physiotherapy will be providing services, at the finish line, at the recommendation of the medical team.

#### **FINISH LINE**

Finishers will be presented with their finisher's medal along with DAJANI bottled water. Keep walking through the chute so as not to prevent other finishers clear passage through the area.

#### **RUNNERS' REFRESHMENTS**

Refreshments will comprise of **DUNKIN'** bagels, bananas, rice cakes, peanut butter cookies, fruit chews and ice cold (local beer). **Must be 18!** 

#### Marathon Race Village is oceanside!

Grab a chair, a carbs and enjoy the natural therapy of an ocean bath. Know of a better way to celebrate after a long haul?

#### INFORMATION SERVICES

At Race Village, there will be an information tent staffed with knowledgeable personnel who can direct you or assist with any queries such as transportation, awards, timing, etc.

#### RACE DAY RUNNER RESULTS

Marathon Bahamas will be utilizing a single-use bib tag – that records each runners official time. In order to receive accurate timing, please make sure your bib is:

- Clearly visible in front of your torso
- Unaltered and unmodified (do not fold or wrinkle)
- Pinned in all four corners
- Not covered (jackets, runners belt, water bottle, etc)
- No activation of the device is necessary

Race results will be posted online at <u>marathonbahamas.com</u>. As participants achieve specific splits along the course, their times will be updated accordingly.

Overall awards will be based on gun time and the masters and age group awards will be based on net time.

There will be a tent, at Race Village, with a QR code for you to obtain your results. The QR code will also be placed on the stage.

#### **MEDALS AND CERTIFICATES**

Each finisher will receive a customized medal for their specific event.

The first, second, and third relay leg will receive their medals at the exchanges. Final relay leg will receive their medal at the finish line. The last relay finisher must return the batons at the finish line.

Completion certificates will be available shortly post-race.
